Our annual roll-a-thon is a fun and fit activity for toddlers and children, with all children reaching for their personal best performance. Students set realistic roll goals based on their Aikido development. Drinks and Lunch will be provided after participant has completed their rolls. Family and friends of students are welcome for lunch as well. There will be prizes for each class for the most rolls and then a grand prize for the student bringing in the greatest total amount of donations, which must be collected and turned in by Friday, March 29th, 2019. Prizes will be awarded based on pledges turned in by that date the following week.

Our goal is to help the fundraising committee raise at least \$5,000 to fund scholarships, needed repairs to the Dojo and sustaining the dojo during the summer months. We hope that each family will participate in the Roll-a-thon to the best of their ability. If each family raises \$500.00, we will easily achieve our goal. We're hoping to make this Roll-a-thon the best ever, so the more contributions you obtain, the more successful we'll be at achieving our goal. Thank you very much for your participation!

Rules

Students may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. **Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be turned in on Roll-a-thon day and all donations need to be turned in by Friday, March 29th, 2019 to qualify for the prizes.**

Pledges may be made by anyone, so be bold with your asking and proud of what you are doing and representing! **Please ask everyone who pledges, if their company has a matching gift fund policy.**

Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, pledge per roll, and maximum pledge. Students may collect the pledge in advance but must keep pledges until all are collected.

On Roll-a-thon day, each student will do as many Aikido rolls as possible. Each student will be monitored by a senior dojo member who will be recording the number of acceptable rolls. Once the student has completed as many rolls as he or she can, the proctor will note the final number on the student's sheet with their signature as validation. Remember, you must stand up after each roll to make it count, but can do a combination roll made up of a forward roll to a backward roll!

Upon completion of the Roll-a-thon, students will hand in their roll sheets. A senior dojo member will record each student's roll total on their pledge sheet and return it. Students may then collect outstanding pledges. **Please return pledge sheets with the money to Makoto Dojo by Friday, March 29th, 2019.** We look forward to all our participants having a great time!
